As the City Council is aware, the City of Carroll is vigorously defending itself against the lawsuit that was filed by Dr. Collison on August 7, 2018. The City has filed a Motion to Dismiss the lawsuit and a Motion for Expedited Consideration. The Court granted the City's Motion for Expedited Consideration and has set a hearing on the Motion to Dismiss for September 17, 2018. The Court also ordered Dr. Collison to alert the Court by September 13, 2018 whether he actually intends to pursue a temporary injunction as he requested in the lawsuit.

Bids were received on the Carroll Public Library/Carroll City Hall construction project on Wednesday, August 29th until 4:00 PM. Overall the bids were favorable for the City. OPN Architects and City Staff will be recommending that the City proceed with accepting the lowest responsive, responsible bid since it came in under budget.

The specifications for the Carroll Public Library/Carroll City Hall construction work anticipated that the project would commence on October 8, 2018. If the City does not start the moving process by September 14th and if asbestos abatement is not started by September 24th the City will not be able to turn the buildings over to the contractor by October 8, 2018.

City staff therefore recommends that the City Council take action to award contracts to move the Carroll Public Library, to move the Carroll City Hall, and to abate the asbestos at 112 E 5th Street and 627 N Adams Street, and to adopt a Resolution authorizing acquisition of real property from Commercial Savings Bank at 627 N Adams Street. These actions must be taken in order to ensure that the building is available on October 8 for the contractor to begin construction.

Because contractors are only required to leave their bids open for 30 days, the City must decide by September 28, 2018 who the lowest responsive, responsible bidder is.

Carroll Public Library

For the Carroll Public Library move City Staff solicited quotes from Library Furniture International and the Iowa Department of Corrections. Both firms have experience in moving libraries like the Carroll Public Library. Library Furniture International quoted the City a total cost of \$21,250 per move. The Iowa Department of Corrections declined submitting a quote due to current staffing issues and the required timeline to move the Library in under 2 weeks.

Carroll City Hall Move

For the Carroll City Hall move City Staff solicited quotes from Pettitt Movers of Carroll and Crimmins Relocation Services of Fort Dodge. Both firms have experience in moving offices like the Carroll City Hall. Pettitt Movers declined submitting a quote due to current staffing levels and the required timeline to move the City Hall starting on a Friday and be complete by Saturday. Crimmins Relocations Services quoted the City a total cost of \$12,150 for the first move and \$9,650 for the second move. The first move includes disassembling, moving, and reassembling of the front office cubicles which will not be moved to the new City Hall site. Staff sought a quote for moving the cubicles from Stones Office Supplies, which declined to bid due to current workloads.

Authorizing acquisition of real property from Commercial Savings Bank at 627 N Adams St

Before the City can proceed on the abatement of asbestos at the former Commercial Savings Bank site at 627 N Adams St, the City needs to formally accept title to the property. Attorney Title Opinion and an updated Phase I ESA have been completed and are clear for the City to accept title on the property.

Abatement of Asbestos at 112 E 5th St and 627 N Adams St

Sealed bids are being sought for the abatement of asbestos at both 112 E 5th St and 627 N Adams St. Four potential bidders participated in a walkthrough of the job site on Tuesday, September 4th. Bids **are were** due at 2:00 PM on Monday, September 10, 2018. The estimated cost is \$80,000. Work would start by September 24th and be completed by October 5th in time for the buildings to be turned over to the main general contractor on October 8th. **The results of the bids will available after bid opening.**

The City received 2 bids for the work as follows:

Site Services of Algona	\$33,908.00
Environmental Property Solutions of Des Moines	\$37,200.00

According to Jon Reis of Impact 7G, both are competent firms and will be able to do the job. Staff is recommending that the City Council accept the bid from Site Services of Algona in the amount of \$33,908.00. Based on the bid price of \$33,908.00, plus professional services of Impact 7G, and a contingency of \$2,500 for additional asbestos that may be found once construction starts the new budget for asbestos abatement is \$54,208.
