MARCH 27, 2017

The Carroll City Council met in regular session on this date at 5:15 p.m. at the Council Chamber of the Farner Government Building. Members present: Misty Boes, LaVern Dirkx, Jerry Fleshner (arrived at 5:16 p.m.), Clay Haley, Mike Kots, and Carolyn Siemann. Absent: None. Mayor Eric Jensen presided and City Attorney Dave Bruner was in attendance.

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The Pledge of Allegiance was led by the City Council. No Council action taken.

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Council Member Fleshner arrived at 5:16 p.m.

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It was moved Haley, seconded by Kots, to approve the minutes of the March 13, 2017 council meeting as written. On roll call, all present voted aye. Absent: None. Motion carried.

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It was moved by Haley, seconded by Kots, to approve the bills and claims in the amount of \$364,226.39. On roll call, all present voted aye. Absent: None. Motion carried.

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It was moved by Haley, seconded by Kots, to approve the following licenses and permits:

CJ Niles and Glenn Babb, Friends of the Library Board Members, addressed Council about Library activities. No Council action taken.

At 5:21 p.m. Mayor Jensen opened a public hearing on a zoning text amendment to the A-2 and A-P zoning districts. Ken Snyder, Journey Senior Services representative, spoke in favor of the zoning text amendment. Mayor Jensen closed said hearing at 5:27 p.m.
