## COUNCIL MEETING

## OCTOBER 9, 2017

The Carroll City Council met in regular session on this date at 5:15 p.m. at the Council Chamber of the Farner Government Building. Members present: Misty Boes, LaVern Dirkx, Jerry Fleshner, Clay Haley, Mike Kots, and Carolyn Siemann. Absent: None. Mayor Eric Jensen presided and City Attorney Dave Bruner was in attendance.

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The Pledge of Allegiance was led by the City Council. No Council action taken.

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It was moved Haley, seconded by Kots, to approve the minutes of the September 25, 2017, council meeting as written. On roll call, all present voted aye. Absent: None. Motion carried.

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It was moved by Haley, seconded by Kots, to approve the bills and claims in the amount of \$898,099.04. On roll call, all present voted aye. Absent: None. Motion carried.

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It was moved by Haley, seconded by Kots, to accept the Tobacco Settlement Agreement from Reiling 71-South. On roll call, all present voted aye. Absent: None. Motion carried.

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It was moved by Kots, seconded by Haley, to proclaim October 8 – 14, 2017 as Fire Prevention Week throughout the community. Volunteer Fire Chief Greg Schreck addressed Council on this issue and introduced the officers of the Volunteer Fire Department. On roll call, all present voted aye. Absent: None. Motion carried.

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It was moved by Haley, seconded by Fleshner, to proclaim October 2017 as Carroll Chamber of Commerce Month in the City of Carroll in recognition of the significance of the Chamber's 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and call to the citizens of the City of Carroll and encourage all residents to support the local businesses within our great community.
