Routine Activities for the month:

The Department responded to six calls for service and held three training sessions in February.

Firefighters continued the process of pressure testing fire hose. Testing should be finished in March. The Department also received refresher CPR training on February 18<sup>th</sup>. This training was provided by personnel from the Carroll County Ambulance Service.

On the evening February 15<sup>th</sup>, the Department responded to one of the more substantial fires we have had over the past several years. The fire involved a 7500 sq. ft. warehouse that was heavily involved in fire upon our arrival. This fire required a substantial amount time, equipment and approximately 40 firefighters to control. We thank our neighboring community fire departments of Arcadia and Glidden for their assistance in controlling this fire.
